OBJECTIVES:

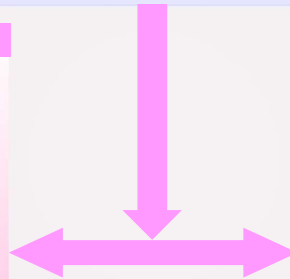
- To provide quality school education, and therapeutic support to every disabled child enrolled in the school
